

DRUGS AND MEDICATION

If medication must be taken during school hours, the California Education Code requires a form to be signed by the physician and parent. Check with the school secretary if you need this form (H-202). All medications, including inhalers, must be in a properly labeled container from the pharmacy. They will be kept in a secure place at school. **Non-prescription drugs (including aspirin and cough lozenges) are not allowed at school.** Do not put any medication in your child's lunch box or backpack. If you have any questions regarding procedures, call the school health clerk or secretary.
